CHANGE IS COMING!

At the beginning of Advent this year the translation of the Bible used in readings at all Masses will change. Currently the Catholic Church uses the "Jerusalem" translation. This will change to the "English Standard Version" with Abbey Psalms and Canticles. This means that, from Advent, our current missals will no longer contain the translation of the readings which will be used during Mass. A sign-up sheet will be put up in the narthex - anyone interested in purchasing a new missal should add their name to this list. It costs £19.95 making it an ideal Christmas present. Once we have an idea of numbers we can order sufficient copies of the missal in time for the change.

Dear Friends and Community,

On Friday 20th September 2024, our dearest friends Don and Noma and their loving family unfortunately lost everything they had built in a tragic house fire. Thankfully, everyone made it out safely, but their home and most of their belongings were lost in the fire. They are forever grateful for their lives, unfortunately though this left them with absolutely nothing in a homeless state. They no longer have a home, clothes or any personal belongings. They are now facing the immense challenge of rebuilding their lives from scratch.
