A Date for your Diary!! Wednesday 25 September 2024 PARISH DAY PILGRIMAGE to OXFORDSHIRE

We will be travelling by coach to visit two historic centres of Catholic interest:

1. Stonor House, near Henley on Thames, is an old Catholic Stately Home which has been in the hands of the same family for over 700 years and where the Mass has been celebrated in their chapel without a break throughout the penal times.

2. Littlemore, on the southern outskirts of Oxford City, where John Henry Newman founded a celibate community of Anglican clergymen in the early 1840s and where he was formally received into the Catholic Church in 1845.

We will meet at St Joseph's for the 10.00 am weekday Mass that day and depart afterwards on our pilgrimage, returning to St Joseph's by around 6.30 pm. The cost is likely to be *approximately* £35, - this is including the coach fare and the admission charge at Stonor House. [Pilgrims will need to bring their own packed lunch].

While it is difficult, at this stage to estimate likely demand, the number of pilgrims which these venues can accommodate is limited to a maximum of 50. Accordingly, we will shortly be asking potential pilgrims to register their interest by paying a £15 deposit. Look out for an announcement in a future Bulletin.

Reporting abuse

If you are concerned about the welfare of a child or adult at risk, do not delay in contacting the police, using 999 if a child or adult is believed to be in immediate danger.

It is the policy of the Catholic Church in England and Wales to report all allegations of abuse to statutory authorities, regardless of whether the abuse occurred recently or in the past, or whether the accused person is living or deceased.

If you are in any role within the Catholic Church in England and Wales, you must refer allegations directly to the safeguarding office for your diocese or religious congregation, or directly to the Police.
