Second SUNDAY of **ADVENT** Year C

This Sunday, we light the second purple candle, with the first, together representing HOPE & LOVE. In today's excerpt from Luke's Gospel, we hear words from Isaiah's prophesy, 'The voice of one crying in the wilderness . . .', coming to fruition when John the Baptist proclaimed, all around Jordan, a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. The essence of John's words are the central message of Advent for us all today and every year - as his urgent cry to 'prepare the way of the Lord', encouraged everyone to be ready for the first coming of Jesus. So too we are called to prepare our soul and body, and announce by our lives, the coming of the Lord, as John did then.
