THIS THURSDAY 13TH MAY IS THE FEAST OF THE ASCENSION

Forty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the great Feast of the Ascension, when Jesus rose up to heaven in front of his disciples. Although Jesus's body became glorified at the moment of his Resurrection, his glory remained hidden, and he ate and drank with them as he had done before his death and resurrection. It is at the moment of his Ascension that his glory comes to light, symbolised by the clouds surrounding him. Since then he has been 'seated at the right hand of the Father', from where he intercedes for us constantly as our mediator, ensuring for us the permanent outpouring of the Holy Spirit. By leaving this earth, he transferred his ministry to his disciples, empowering them to carry on what he had started, and promising them that although they could no longer see him, he would always be with them, and that soon he would send the Holy Spirit to give them the inspiration and courage they would need to continue their ministry. Ten days after the Ascension we then celebrate PENTECOST, when Jesus' promise to his disciples is fulfilled. A 9-day novena is traditionally observed leading up to this feast. 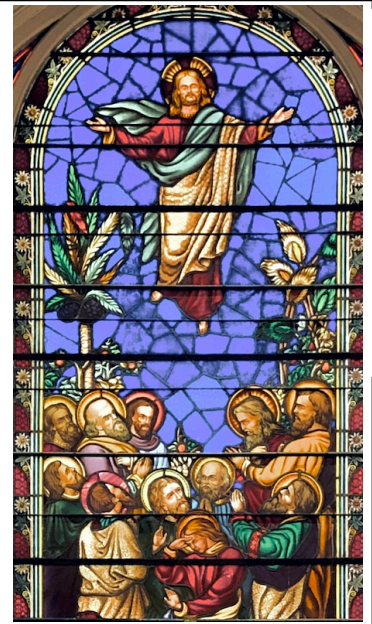

Thank you to all those who have kindly volunteered to act as stewards, so that we can safely re-open the church for you all for the 10am Mass on Mondays and Fridays, which at this point are being live-streamed only. **We are now in a position to re-open to the public for 10am Mass on Fridays, beginning from this week - so from Friday 14th May.** We hope to re-open on Mondays too in a few weeks' time.
