OUR LENTEN CHARITIES - You can still support our Lenten Charities for one more week! Read about their work below:

The Jesuit Refugee Service [JRS] (Home Charity), is an international Catholic organisation, at work in over 50 countries around the world with a mission to ACCOMPANY, SERVE and ADVOCATE on behalf of refugees and other forcibly displaced persons. JRS in the UK [helped by many volunteers] has a special ministry to those who find themselves destitute and those detained in immigration procedures. JRS UK runs a day centre in Wapping currently in covid times for food and toiletries. JRS UK also provides mobile phone top ups, fortnightly £15 Equals Cards, volunteer hosting, emotional and legal support for destitute asylum seekers and newly recognised refugees and detention outreach services to Heathrow IRC and other Immigration Removal Centres.

The Cornelian Maternity & Rural Health Care Facility located at Gidan Mangoro in the outskirts of Abuja, Nigeria (Overseas Charity). This clinic is administered by the Holy Child Sisters under the leadership of Sr Magdalene Nwaenyi. It provides primary health care to rural women and children who would be otherwise unable to access medical care.


