Our **Lenten Home Charity** this year has been THE BAYTREE CENTRE in Brixton: "**Changing aspirations into realities** – we inspire and support women and girls to gain the skills, confidence and wisdom they need to thrive in life, work and family", from the charity's website <u>baytreecentre.org</u> - visit for more information.

Our **Overseas Lenten Charity** was introduced by Fr Jude Nnorom CSSp:

"Permit me once again to make a request on behalf of the Spiritan community in Bicheratanga in Yendi diocese in the Northern region of Ghana. Our Brothers are ministering to the people in this rural area which has about 12 outstations. Because of its isolated location, Bicheratanga experiences a lot the migration of young people from the villages in search of better opportunities in the bigger cities of Kumasi and Accra. Given the rough terrain of some of the access roads to the villages, our brothers rely on motor bikes for their ministries. Although apprehensive of motor bikes, I rode with them when I visited Bicheratanga in last April. Unfortunately, the only motor bike they use has broken down due to age and long years of service and they would be grateful to be assisted to get another one that will facilitate their ministry".
